First meeting- March 16, 1935

Officers elected: President- Lawrence D Hayford; Vice President- Milton J Seeley; Secretary- F Lincoln Steele, Jr.; Treasurer- Richard W Read. Additional members: Wilbur C Goodson, R C Spaulding, Roland E Currier, Harry F Damon, Roy E Arling, Earle H Remick, and Walter Bookholtz.

State Of New Hampshire- Articles of Agreement (Initial):

Dated August 7, 1935.

Article 1. The name of this corporation shall be Tamworth Outing Club

Article 2. The object for which this corporation is established is to promote and encourage out-door sports and recreation, and to furnish or otherwise secure facilities for the same; and to aid in such development of the region as is consistent with its character and the thought of its inhabitants.

Article 3. The place in which the business of this corporation is to be carried on is Tamworth, New Hampshire.

Article 4. The amount of capital stock or number of shares is NONE.

Important Projects:

- ∞ Page Hill Project (ski slope)- voted to adopt, August 2, 1935. Trail clearing and rope tow established in late 1936. First race competition was in February 27, 1937.
- ∞ Sled dog race- voted to sponsor the race, November 17, 1936. First Race was on March 7, 1937.
- ∞ First dances- Held at Huckins Barn, rented by the TOC. The first dance was on July 28, 1937. 70 people attended and the orchestra was paid \$11. Dances were also held in winter with the warmth of the stone fireplace.
- ∞ Ski trail cut on Mt Whittier- 1937, in cooperation with the W.P.A.
